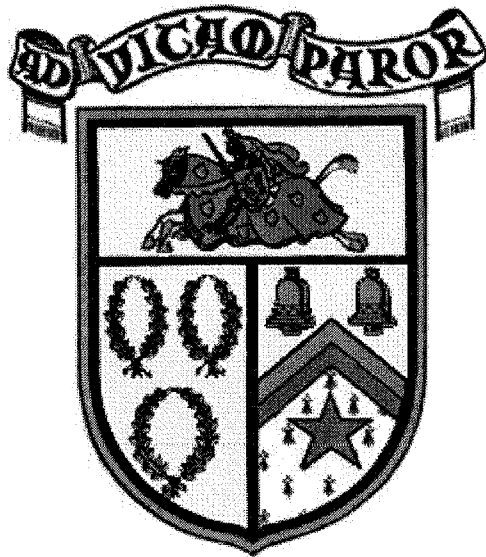

Pupil Instructions

We are now in a position to give you some very important examination dates. It would be worthwhile noting them in your Diary Planner as well as using the calendar provided at the back of this booklet.

Advice given to you by both your subject teachers and Social Education staff should have prepared you for these assessments. Please remember it is now your responsibility to plan your study and be fully ready for these important examinations. As you will know, the evidence of attainment which these Prelims provide will be required if you are unable, for any reason, to sit the S.Q.A. exams in May and may be required if you sit the final exams but perform below expectations.

The exam dates and times are detailed in the next three pages. Please note the following when using this timetable:

1. Any pupils that require special arrangements to be made for exams will be advised of the times and locations by Mrs Smith, Principal Teacher Pupil Support. These may differ from the main timetable.
2. Not all subjects and levels will be assessed during this two week period; some will utilise timetabled periods at different times over the year or have their own specific arrangements.
3. Your seat numbers will be confirmed by your class teacher prior to the exams.
4. Where you have two different exams timetabled for the same date and time, separate instructions will be issued to you confirming when you should sit each exam.
5. Please take some time to read the information on examination conduct, contained on the back of the calendar.

Finally, if you have any questions regarding the timetable, please speak to the appropriate class teacher as soon as possible.

Prelim Examinations Pupil Conduct

Prelim examinations are important examinations. They allow you to judge your progress within a subject, and allow teachers to predict your future attainment and may be used as the basis of information for appeals.

It is therefore expected that conduct in the examination rooms is of the highest standard, allowing all pupils to demonstrate their ability.

Examination Conduct

Do:

- Ensure that you know the location and time of each examination.
- Make sure you arrive in good time for each examination.
- Sit in assigned seat.
- Only leave the examination when indicated to by invigilator, you may be required to remain in examination hall for the full duration of the exam.
- Bring appropriate equipment, e.g. pen, pencil, ruler, calculator, dictionary (where permitted).
- Listen carefully to any special instructions issued by the examiner.
- Complete all rough working on examination booklet or paper provided for the purpose.
- Leave bags in designated areas.
- Wear normal school uniform.
- Return to class after each exam.

Don't:

- Take in any unauthorised aids, e.g. books, notes, paper, mobile phones, spellcheckers, etc.
- Communicate with or give assistance to any other candidates.
- Cause a disturbance in the examination room.
- Submit work which is frivolous, abusive or offensive.
- Remove examination materials from the room.
