

Recommended Uniform

Pupils should attend wearing school uniform, choosing from the options given below. All pupils are required to be identifiably pupils of Bell Baxter High School.

White Shirt or Blouse and School Tie with Navy or Black Jersey or Top
OR
White Polo Shirt with School Crest or Navy Sweatshirt with School Crest

Blue Blazer with badge.
OR
Navy / dark jacket or anorak.
(Jackets with emblems / designer slogans are not acceptable).

Navy or black trousers or skirt

Dark Shoes
(Trainers are not recommended)

On formal occasions pupils will be expected to wear shirt/blouse and school tie.

NOTES:

1. Sweatshirts and polo shirts all with the school crest are available throughout the year from the School. Order forms, which can be obtained from the Office, are distributed to pupils and prospective pupils around the Easter holiday period.
2. Denim and leather garments and shell suits should not be worn to school. Similarly, pullovers and sweatshirts with designer slogans / emblems should not be worn.
3. Parents are advised of the safety advantages of reflective material when used with outdoor garments.

Note: As pupils have to move about a widely scattered site with little shelter from bad weather, it is advisable that they should carry with them some sort of protective clothing such as a cagoule and use appropriate footwear.

For obvious reasons, the school would appreciate support from parents in forbidding pupils from wearing to school supporters' scarves, jerseys and other badges and emblems associated with professional football and similar organisations.

In view of their potential risk as a fire hazard, we ask parents to ensure that shell suits are not worn to school.
